

“God’s Greatness Revealed”

“It is Finished” Part 4

John 12:20-33
March 28, 2010

As we continue to in our Lenten study, we hear in this Palm Sunday encounter of Jesus four important words and phrases and that give us some important insights into the cross. Those four are ...

“Glorify” = “to manifest and honor greatness”

*“The hour has come for the Son of Man **to be glorified.**” (vs. 23)*

“Father, glorify your name.” Then a voice came from heaven, “I have glorified it, and will glorify it again.” (vs. 28)

“Hour” = “the time for Jesus’ death”

*“**The hour has come** for the Son of Man to be glorified.” (vs. 23)*

“Kernel of wheat” = “one who exists to sacrifice”

“I tell you the truth, unless a kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a single seed. But if it dies, it produces many seeds.” (vs. 24)

“Lifted up” = “crucifixion and glorification”

“But I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to myself.” (vs. 32)

Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: Who being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death— even death on a cross! Therefore God exalted him to the highest place ... (Php. 2:5-9)

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“Lifted up” = “_____and_____”

“But I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to myself.” (vs. 32)

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
