Today after looking back over Revelation 4-5, we focus on how God’s people are to respond to this glorious image of Jesus. We start by recalling that in Revelation ...

The most frequent command is “Look!”

“Look! An open door!”

Behold, a door standing open in heaven! (vs. 4:1 ESV)

“Look! A throne with Someone on it!”

Behold, a throne stood in heaven, with one seated on the throne (vs. 4:2 ESV)

“Look! The Lion who is a Lamb!”

“See, the Lion ...has triumphed. He is able to open the scroll” Then I saw a Lamb, looking as if it had been slain, standing in the center of the throne (vs. 5:5-6)

We respond to this reality in worship, by ...

... recognizing we are Jesus’ possessions

... with your blood you purchased men for God from every tribe and language and people and nation (vs. 10)

... living as Jesus’ representatives

You have made them to be a kingdom and priests to serve our God ... (vs. 10)

... learning to serve as Jesus’ co-regents

... and they will reign on the earth vs. 10)

... God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus... (Eph. 2:6)

We do this by ...

... bearing witness

These are the words of the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the ruler of God’s creation... (Rev. 3:14)

... being an intercessor

Christ Jesus ... is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us (Rom. 8:34)

... they were holding golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints (Rev. 5:8)

... embracing martyrdom
