*I heard the number of those who were sealed:  
144,000 from the tribes of Israel. (vs. 4)*

... **a multitude of multi-ethnic-cultural people**

*I looked, and there before me was a great multitude  
that no one could count from every nation, tribe,  
people and language ... (vs. 9)*

**This assures us of a glorious future in which ...**

... **we will be in God’s presence**

*... standing before the throne and the Lamb. (vs. 9)*

... **there will be no more suffering**

*Never again will they hunger; never again will they  
thirst. The sun will not beat upon them, nor any  
scorching heat. (vs. 16)*
