Quick Info Sheet

Location: Black Mesa, AZ (Western Navajo Nation)

Transportation: We will be driving rented vans

Estimated cost: \$600-650/person. There will be fundraisers and opportunities to bring cost down.

Opportunity:

- Partner with local church that is ministering year-round to this community
- Hard work, like repair/remodel projects, dry walling, roofing, etc. For the local church and/or local families in the community
- Outreach and relational ministry. There will be opportunities to build relationships with people in the church and the surrounding community. And, we will be leading anywhere between 2-4 days of their Kids Club ministry, which will be similar to summer day camp at MHPC.

Activities/Schedule:

- Morning devotionals and time of silence
- Evening worship (worship, prayer and Experience Mission staff led messages). Followed by MHPC group debrief time.
- Typical day will consist of groups going out to work projects or Kids Club ministries.
- We will be staying at the church (you will want to plan on bringing an air mattress or sleeping pad).
- No showers at the church, but there will be a makeshift camping type shower stall outside.
- All the food will be prepared by Experience Mission Staff.
